



# Why did the City declare a state of financial emergency?

### A BRIEF OVERVIEW...

- Budget Deficit of \$400 million this year
- Covid-19 Impact on the 7 Economically Sensitive Taxes
- Structural Deficit of over \$750 million over the next four years
- City Hall approved unsustainable labor agreements
- Includes gap of \$228 million next year
- Reserve Fund below minimum levels

# Budget Deficits and the need to Balance the Budget
